ADOLESCENT GIRLS LITERACY +, MALAWI

Dorothy finished school and talks very highly of her time in education as she feels she has benefitted hugely from learning to read and write. Before AGLIT+'s combined literacy and health education programme, most girls in the area were illiterate but, thanks to your generous support, the girls are now able to focus on school and learning. Dorothy reflects on her education through AGLIT+:

'I was a learner in the class of 2019, I have benefited a lot with these classes in a way that now I can read and write, and all this from this school. Along the way we had a disaster, we had floods that blew off roofs of houses and destroyed our crops too. Whilst in that state, All We Can acted swiftly and came to our aid, they distributed clothes to us as parents and our children and that was a relief to all of us. They did not stop there but continued to assist us with food for our children. According to how bad the situation was we feel that we were greatly helped.'



'Before this school came most of us were illiterate and had nothing to do, but right after this school came, we rushed and registered immediately. We started classes and begun to read and write and solve mathematical problems. On top of that, some of us became settled and left our old ways and focussed on this school. My advice to my fellow ladies is that if this programme is still continuing let them come and register so that they can be taught- I encourage them to come. I would like to say thank you because of the decision to come and give us education, because we know there are a lot of people with resources who cannot help others and I want to ask them to continue and give this opportunity to others like me who also need this school.'
